The NYS Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services (DHSES) is pleased to announce the release of the "Grant Guidance and Application Materials" for the FY2020 Explosive Detection Canine Team Grant Program. Explosive Detection Canine Teams provide a visible, proactive police presence in areas of mass gathering, transportation centers and critical infrastructure sites. In addition to this deterrence presence, they provide a mobile response capability for detection and identification of potential explosive device type incidents. DHSES recognizes the integral role explosive detection canine teams play in counter-IED operations and as such, has devoted funding through this program to support this community.

Only local, county and tribal law enforcement agencies with an active road patrol component to their law enforcement operations <u>and</u> who currently and/or previously managed a DCJS or NYSP certified explosive detection canine team within the last five (5) years, are eligible to apply for funds under this grant program. Funding will be allocated competitively. The Request for Applications (RFA) and associated materials are available at the following link: https://www.dhses.ny.gov/targeted-grants

Applications are due to DHSES by <u>May 5, 2022, by 5:00pm</u>. Late applications will not be accepted, and no extensions will be granted.
