WHEREAS, By Resolution No. 573 for 2023, this Honorable Body authorized an agreement with the New York State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services, Office of Interoperable and Emergency Communications regarding the Public Safety Answering Points Operations Grant Program in the amount of \$235,855 for the term commencing January 1, 2023 and ending December 31, 2023, and

WHEREAS, By Resolution No. 45 for 2024, this Honorable Body amended the agreement to reflect a term ending December 31, 2024 rather than December 31, 2023, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff has requested authorization to amend the agreement to reflect a new term end date of September 30, 2025 rather than December 31, 2024, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that Resolution No. 573 for 2023, as amended, is amended to reflect a term ending September 30, 2025, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said amendment as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
