The Department of General Services requests authorization to enter into an agreement with John W. Danforth Company for boiler replacement at the Mercantile Building at a cost of \$120,485.00 which includes a 10% Contingency Allowance of the Base Proposal Price (\$109,531.20 + \$10,953.80). The Department of General Services & Facilities Engineering Division solicited a bid price for the Boiler replacement Project at 60 South Pearl Street Mercantile Building utilizing the Town of Greece, NY statewide Job Order Contracting Services. The Town of Greece extends these services to other eligible governmental entities including all government agencies, education agencies including colleges and universities pursuant to NYS General Municipal Law, allowing them access to complete repair, renovation and maintenance services at competitively solicited prices. Albany County Purchasing Division has also determined that the Town of Greece, NY statewide Job Order Contracting Services meets the requirements of N.Y. Gen. Mun. Law and the County's Procurement Policies.
