Dear Mr. Joyce

The Water Purification District (District) is requesting authorization to accept an Engineering Planning Grant (EPG) from Environmental Facilities Corporation (EFC) for up to fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000). As a condition of the grant, the County is required to match 20% of the grant amount for a maximum amount of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000). This grant will be used towards funding a portion of the engineering study for the District's Capital Improvement Plan Project.

As a condition of the grant acceptance EFC also requires the following resolutions prior to executing a grant agreement with the County.

- 1. Resolution designating an Authorized Representative for the project.
- 2. Resolution authoring and obligating the District to match 20% of the total grant funds.
- 3. Resolution designating the engineering study as a SEQR Type II action

With the acceptance of the grant, the District requests approval of the resolutions listed above and asks that the Executive Director of the Water Purification District be designated at the Authorized representative for the project.

A copy of the EPG award letter from EFC is enclosed along with a memo from the Albany County Department of Economic Development identifying the above referenced engineering study as a SEQR Type II action.

Unless otherwise notified by EFC, you must submit all required supporting documentation to EFC by June 30, 2022 and execute a grant agreement with EFC no later than October 31, 2022 to avoid possible forfeiture of the grant.
