WHEREAS, The Albany County Sheriff has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the New York State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services in order to accept 2023 Statewide Interoperability Communications Grant-Formula Based Funding in an amount of \$1,175,916 for a term commencing January 1, 2023 and ending December 31, 2025, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff has indicated that the aforementioned grant funds will be utilized to build upon the Albany County 911 Interoperable Communications System, and

WHEREAS, The Sheriff has also requested a budget amendment to incorporate the aforementioned grant funding into the 2023 Sheriff's Office Budget, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the New York State Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services in order to accept 2023 Statewide Interoperability Communications Grant-Formula Based Funding in an amount of \$1,175,916 for a term commencing January 1, 2023 and ending December 31, 2025, and, be it further

I am pleased to announce that Albany County has been awarded \$1,175,916 under the New York State 2023 Statewide Interoperable Communications Grant Program (2023 SICG-Formula). This program, administered by my agency, allows for the State support to aid county, local and municipal public safety organizations in enhancing emergency response, improving capability, improvements in governance structures, operating procedures, infrastructure development, and addressing SAFECOM guidance from the U.S. Department of Homeland Security Office of Emergency Communications (OEC). The 2023 SICG-Formula Program will concentrate on improving interoperability and operability of communications systems in New York State.
