WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Albany County Department of Social Services has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the New York State Industries for the Disabled regarding ancillary laundry services for eligible individuals in the Expanded In-Home Services for the Elderly Program in the amount of \$100,000 for the term commencing April 1, 2020 and ending March 31, 2021, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner indicated that New York State Industries for the Disabled will subcontract with Plaza Linens to provide laundry bags, pick up, delivery, cleaning and processing of laundry, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the New York State Industries for the Disabled, Albany, NY 12203 regarding ancillary laundry services for eligible individuals in the Expanded In-Home Services for the Elderly Program in an amount not to exceed \$100,000 for the term commencing April 1, 2020 and ending March 31, 2021, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate State and County Officials.
