DESCRIPTION OF REQUEST: (state briefly why legislative action is requested)

The County Executive's Office is seeking approval from the Legislature to amend a contract and add a one year extension for the agreement with the New York Power Authority for routine and non-routine maintenance of the County's streetlights. The routine maintenance consists of replacing and/or repairing defective components of the street lighting system in order to keep them fully operational. Non-routine maintenance includes repairs that go above and beyond the routine repairs and requires customer approval before work is completed. The attached sample agreement provides a further description of these maintenance categories. The County will be charged \$3,150.00 for routine maintenance per year for routine maintenance and will be billed for non -routine maintenance on an as-needed basis at an amount not to exceed \$9,050.66 per year.
