**AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE NEW YORK STATE OFFICE
FOR THE AGING REGARDING THE TITLE III-D MEDICATION
MANAGEMENT PROGRAM**

By Elder Care Committee:

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of the Department for Aging has requested authorization to enter into an agreement with the New York State Office for the Aging to accept Title III-D Medication Management Program funding in the amount of \$19,736 for the term commencing January 1, 2023 and ending December 31, 2023, and

WHEREAS, The Commissioner has indicated that the funding, which requires a 10% County match, will be used to support evidence-based health promotion, disease prevention, and recreational programs for older adults living in Albany County, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with the New York State Office for the Aging to accept Title III-D Medication Management Program funding in the amount of \$19,736 for the term commencing January 1, 2023 and ending December 31, 2023, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreement as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
