Albany County Department of Public Works is requesting authorization to apply for 2023 Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) funding for pedestrian and bicycle improvements along various Albany County Roadways. Awards will amount to no less than \$500,000 and no more than \$5 million for any single project. NYSDOT will provide up to 80 percent of the total eligible project costs with a minimum 20 percent match provided by Albany County. Project costs may include planning, design/engineering services, right-of-way acquisition, construction, and construction inspection. For example, DPW is pursuing funding for sidewalks along CR157 New Karner Rd from Western Ave to Washington Ave Extension. The number of project will depend upon the amount of funding awarded. For now we are requesting approval to apply for this funding.

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
