DESCRIPTION OF REQUEST: (state briefly why legislative action is requested)

New York State flew Albany County this spring to collect new aerial imagery. The County had the opportunity to upgrade the resolution of the imagery in portions of the County from 1ft. to 1/2 foot for an additional cost. The upgraded resolution is important for use in GIS, planning, economic development, law enforcement, emergency management, and for local assessors. The Department is seeking authorization to enter into an agreement with New York State in the amount not to exceed \$41,000 toward the cost of imaging upgrades. The cost was anticipated and included in the 2024 budget.
