<u>DESCRIPTION OF REQUEST:</u> (state briefly why legislative action is requested)

The Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP) is federally funded, and in New York State, overseen by the Office of Temporary and Disability Assistance (OTDA). HEAP aims to alleviate the financial burden of heating and related costs for low-income households throughout Albany County.

The Department of Social Services (DSS) serves as the lead local agency responsible for HEAP outreach, certification, and payment services, and is encouraged by OTDA to maintain a local network and partner with a non-DSS site to share the responsibility of HEAP outreach and certification. Therefore, DSS requests authorization to contract with Cornell Cooperative Extension of Albany County (CCE) to assist with the provision of HEAP outreach and certification services to residents throughout Albany County.
