

RESOLUTION NO. 514

AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDING FROM NEW YORK STATE DIVISION OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND EMERGENCY SERVICES REGARDING EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS INITIATIVES AND AMENDING THE 2018 ALBANY COUNTY BUDGET

By Public Safety and Audit and Finance Committees and Messrs. Beston, Bullock, Clenahan, Ms. McKnight, Messrs. Miller, Ward and Ms. Willingham:

WHEREAS, By Resolution 303 for 2018 this Honorable Body authorized the submission of a grant application to the NYS Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services (DHSES) regarding Emergency Preparedness Initiatives, and

WHEREAS, Grant funding has been awarded in the amount of \$452,000 as part of the FY 2018 State Homeland Security Program, and

WHEREAS, The sum of \$303,075 will be allocated to the Albany County Department of Health, the sum of \$128,925 will be allocated to the Albany County Department of Information Services and \$20,000 will be allocated to the Department of General Services, and

WHEREAS, The Departments of Information Services and General Services require budget amendments to incorporate the funds into their respective 2018 budgets, now, therefore be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into an agreement with NYS DHSES regarding grant funding for Emergency Preparedness Initiatives in an amount not to exceed \$452,000, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the 2018 Department of Information Services budget is amended as follows:

Increase Revenue Account A3306 Homeland Security by \$128,925

Increase Appropriation Account 1680.2 by increasing Line Item A1680 2 2050 Computer Equipment by \$85,925

Increase Appropriation Account 1680.4 by increasing Line Item A1680 4 4046 Fees for Services by \$43,000

and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the 2018 Department of General Services budget is amended as follows:

Increase Revenue Account A3306 Homeland Security by \$20,000

Increase Appropriation Account A1164.4 by increasing Line Item A1164 44046 Fees for Services by \$20,000

RESOLVED, That the County Attorney is authorized to approve said agreements as to form and content, and, be it further

RESOLVED, That the Clerk of the County Legislature is directed to forward certified copies of this resolution to the appropriate County Officials.
