WHEREAS, The County Executive has now requested authorization to sub-award a portion of this funding to Albany LEAD partners, including the Public Defender Association/LEAD National Support Bureau, Catholic Charities Care Coordination Services, the Center for Law and Justice, and the Albany Police Department, now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, By the Albany County Legislature that the County Executive is authorized to enter into agreements with the Public Defender Association/LEAD National Support Bureau, Seattle, Washington 98104; Catholic Charities Care Coordination Services, Albany, New York 12204; the Center for Law and Justice, Albany, New York 12204; and the Albany Police Department in connection with subawarding grant funds in the amount of \$785,850 for the term commencing October 1, 2020 and ending September 30, 2023, and, be it further
