Justification: (state briefly why legislative action is requested)

Leasing Suite # 17 for a 3 year period - term as noted above. This is a new agreement however the suite holder (MVP Health Care) has been a 50% suite holder in a different suite (# 13) with Protective Industrial Equipment for many years. MVP will be leasing the entire suite (#17) as of the reopening of the TU Center and for three years thereafter. MVP paid \$1,500 as a deposit previously to renew their share of suite (#13). That prepaid deposit is being applied towards the required \$3,000, which must accompany the Letter of Intent. A check in the amount of \$1,500 (copy attached) has been received so MVP now has paid \$3,000 and the deposit will be applied to payments owed by MVP in year #1 once the lease agreement is signed. A Letter of Intent has also been signed to take over Suite (#17). We will bring another RLA in the near future for a company that will fill the 50% share of suite (#13), which is the suite that MVP was in previously.
