<u>Justification</u>: (state briefly why legislative action is requested)

New York State Department of Health has issued a 12-month extension of grant contracts for the Adolescent Tobacco Enforcement Program. This extension is a 12 month extension at the current level of funding of \$93,347 per year. This extension brings the full term of the contract to 6 years (4/1/2018-3/31/2024) and the full amount to \$560,082 (\$93,347 a year). The funds are used to enforce the Adolescent Tobacco Use Prevention Act (ATUPA) and the Clean Indoor Air Act (CIAA). Activities done by ACDOH include establishing and maintaining a list of tobacco retail dealers and vendors, entering compliance check and enforcement data, performing compliance checks, and establishing and maintaining an up to date record of all CIAA related complaints and actions taken to resolve complaints.
